- Four graduate programs:

ADMISSION

Admission to the graduate program requires spiritually mature Christian men and women to hold an earned bachelors degree from an accredited institution, or its equivalent. In addition, potential students must agree with the seminary's doctrinal statement and policies. Those without a bachelor's degree may enter either the Certificate or Audit program.
